



Portfolio Approach

- ...Pilot Cities of varying sizes and that reflect different starting points for cities, so as to reflect the diversity of contexts
- and maximise learning, replication, and scaling potential across the EU.
- This 'portfolio approach' ensures an EU-level innovation and learning dimension (i.e., addressing challenges of/at European scale and potentially relevant for many cities to meet European policy objectives) is achieved, as it evolves over the course of the programme.
- A balanced representation of contexts is the most conducive means towards the EC Missions target of change at the EU level, which goes beyond what can be achieved at the level of individual regions and nations.
- The selection of Pilot Cities to join the existing portfolio will result in multiple pilot-activity-types, each of which generates a different test of change and proves diverse types of pathways – as such, a cohort of diverse pilots.






Pilot Cities Programme Cohort 1:

A geographic view of cities/districts (53) across 25 projects


